I have a new symptom and not sure if it's a relapse.

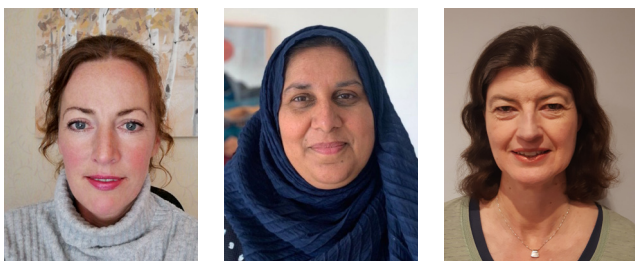
I was diagnosed with ME/FND but I think it's MS.

Who can access the service?

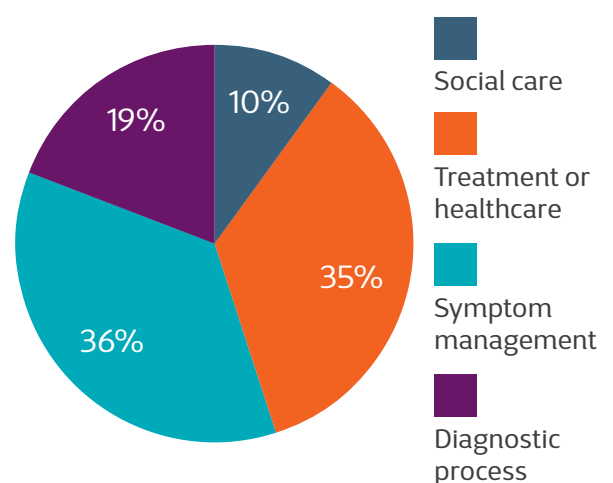
Anyone affected by multiple sclerosis.
